Nomination & Selection Process (GCIM-Based & Transparent)

1. GCIM Members Nomination System

- Nominations for all categories will be invited exclusively from registered members of GCIM (Global Community of Indian Music).
- This ensures a large, diverse, knowledgeable, and democratically participating pool of genuine listeners, artists, teachers, and supporters.
- The nomination process will be completely online, transparent, and audit-friendly.

2. Primary Shortlisting

• Based on the number of nominations received, the top shortlisted candidates in each category will be presented to the Awards Jury.

3. Awards Jury

- A prestigious panel comprising maestros, scholars, senior artistes, researchers, producers, and culture experts.
- Jury decisions will blend artistic merit, impact, authenticity, and overall contribution.

4. Final Selection & Announcement

- Winners will be selected through a combination of GCIM public nominations and jury evaluation.
- All processes will be published clearly to maintain credibility and transparency.
